1 E3V bible (Lower School office has them for \$10) - labeled with child's harrie
1 standard backpack (no wheels) - labeled with child's name
1 beach towel to sit on outside (for class or picnic lunches) - labeled with child's name
1 old t-shirt (adult size) for ART class - labeled with child's name
1 reusable water bottlelabeled with child's name
1 folder - horizontal pockets w/out prongs
2 Mead Composition Journals2 primary lined (top half is blank for pictures)
1 yellow vinyl folder with pockets
1 pack of washable markers in primary colors (8-10 count)
2 boxes of 24 count crayons
1 box of <u>24 count</u> colored pencils
2 packs of pencils (no mechanical pencils)
2 pink rectangular erasers
1 pouch with zipper (needs to hold: markers, 5 pencils, colored pencils, 1 eraser, 1 glue stick
and 1 whiteboard marker)
4-6 permanent glue sticks (Scotch or Staples make a permanent glue stick)
1 package of dry erase markers
1 Bottle of Elmers Glue
1 box of bandaids
2 boxes of facial tissues (prefer square for easy storage)
1 bottle of hand sanitizer (with at least 60% alcohol)
1 box of Ziploc bags (boys bring gallon size: girls bring sandwich size)
1 container of Clorox/Lysol Wipes
"Goody Box" Items - small toys, non-candy (welcomed throughout year)
Headphones (Not Earbuds) for your child's use at school (labeled with child's name)
